

The main activities of each SG are international conferences, publications and workshops. We recommend that you join between 5-7 SGs in order to ensure optimal engagement.

If you want to be more deeply involved in the work conducted by these groups, you can be nominated to join the SG Management Committees, play a role in the organisation of specialised conferences, or volunteer to create or participate in focused Task Groups or Clusters.


