

Concerns/Issues

Specialist groups are siloed

Some groups struggle to connect with members (Passive Engagement)

Long sessions with overloaded content and discussion should be avoided

Good communication among MC members and with SG members is crucial.

Possible solution

Collaboration is not just needed but is essential

More opportunities for informal communication (at least 2 meetings – virtually - per year)

Short and interactive sessions

SGs should put more effort into developing an annual work plan of key activities to share with SG Leaders (and their members!)

KEY POINTS FROM SG LEADERS FORUM AT 2022 WWC&E



Engagement opportunities:

- <u>Joint conferences and webinars</u> to increase participation/attendance and help spread the workload and avoid members feeling overwhelmed
- <u>SGs Open meetings</u> at SGs conferences if leaders of other SGs are present
- SGs can come together to <u>write books</u>
- SG Leaders could have joint members meetings to share info (e.g., thematic meetings)
- Smaller events like a <u>1-day workshop organised</u> by different SGs
- Use <u>IWA Connect plus</u> for better engagement among SG Leaders and with members
- Develop a <u>common strategy on how to involve not-members</u> so that they become members
